### TIGERS REACH NEW HEIGHTS

Glenelg Football Club will reach new heights during their round 20 home match against North on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> August when skydivers land on Challenge Recruitment Oval prior to the commencement of the league match at 2pm.

SA Skydiving, responsible for the awesome skydiving demonstration with 22 people landing onto AAMI stadium including Mark "Roo" Ricciuto prior to the Adelaide vs Essendon clash on May 30<sup>th</sup> 2008 will orchestrate the jump onto the Oval.

"It's an exciting opportunity for us to have something so unique and spectacular in the lead up to our league match. It will definitely add to the atmosphere which has been present at our home matches this season." Chief Executive Officer Darren Chandler commented.

S.A. Skydiving is a professional training organisation approved by the Australian Parachute Federation and the Civil Aviation Safety Authority.

Glenelg will take on traditional adversary North Adelaide for the third time this season, second time on the Tigers home ground. Glenelg has won the previous four encounters against the Roosters, who last defeated the Tigers in round 20, 2006.

The clash is promises to be a tight and contested battle with the Tigers fighting to re-gain their top place on the ladder and Roosters desperate to secure their spot in the five and claim their position in the finals.

The Club encourages all members and supporters to get down to the Bay on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> of August and share in the excitement as skydivers land onto the oval in the prelude to an thrilling match between two formidable sides.

Supporters are urged to get to the match early, with crowds at the Bay averaging well over 5,000 a game for the year to date. Gates open at 10:30am and the Reserves match will begin at 11am to allow time for the skydive onto the oval before the league game kicks off at 2pm.
