Hi! I'm Adam Beaumont and I'd like to share my story.

Last year on the 18th of December, my mum Sharon Beaumont (Shaz) passed away at 51 after fighting for 20 long hard months with pancreatic cancer. Mum was diagnosed with pancreatic cancer in 2016, which then in June 2017 spread to her head resulting in 7 brain tumours, and then in December 2017 it got the best of her and took her life. Mum was a very strong woman, who would do anything for anyone. In honour of mum I have decided to ride from Adelaide to Melbourne to raise awareness and try help get rid of this disease. In October this year myself along with 3 other close friends and 4 support crew including my Dad, will travel just over 1,000 kms via the Great Ocean road over 9 days finishing at the MCG, as mum was a massive footy fan.
